Use the glockenspiel creatively to produce sound effects and perform ideas. Work with confidence in small groups to improve work, compose, improvise and develop techniques.




PE

Maths

This term, **Y1** will be covering the topics of:

- Statistics
- Position and direction

Science

The science this term will be focused on Scientific Investigation. We will be looking at things scientifically, working out what we know, what we want to know, how we might go about finding this out, what we think will happen, testing our idea, recording what we see with our senses or measurements and then attempting to explain it to see if our ideas of what would happen were correct.

Year 1 will be learning about digital painting.

Art/DT

In art this term, we will be looking at architecture. We will begin by looking at architects and the way in which they work. The children will then be designing and making their own architectural model.
