Curriculum Information

English

Year 1: This term in English, the children will be learning how to write simple sentences which include capital letters, finger spaces and full stops. The children will continue to apply their knowledge of phonics in their writing, and add simple adjectives and verbs to create interest. Children will continue to read a range of books and verbally demonstrate their understanding.

Year 2: This term in English, the children will be learning how to write more complex sentences which include commas and a range of sentence starters. The children will continue to complete their spelling lesson each day and apply alternative graphemes to their writing. Children will learn about adverbs and consolidate their understanding of verbs and adjectives. Children will continue to read a range of books and demonstrate their understanding through written answers.

Mathematics



This term the children will continue to learn about place value and consolidate their understanding of addition and subtraction. Year one will learn about measurements and year two will move on to multiplication. Both year groups will be learning about 2D and 3D shapes.

Religious Education

This term the children will ask and answer the question 'What is the Good News that Jesus brings? We will also be learning about the first Easter.

History

This term we will be Learning about the Terra Nova Expedition and the race to the South Pole. We will be learning about the historical aspects of how Scott of the Antarctica and his team made the journey and compare this to expeditions today.

Geography

The children will learn about their place in the world and focus on our local community. Children will learn about the place they live and go to school. They will understand how to use and follow simple maps and we will be walking to Rudyard lake as a field trip.



Science

As scientists, children will continue their work on habitats, looking specifically at the polar regions. Children will then move on to looking at their own body and what we need to be healthy.

Design and Technology

This term, the children will be looking at mechanisms. They will design, make, fly and evaluate their own kite.
