




Geography

This term, we will be learning about the geographical features of the seaside, both human and physical. Children will learn about seaside environments; finding out where they are located in the United Kingdom. Children will learn about the similarities and differences between seaside resorts and their own locality, looking at how resorts have changed over time.

History

For the second part of this term, we will be looking at the history Josiah Wedgwood and his impact on Stoke on Trent. We will be leaning what life was like as a potter in the past and asking the questions: What are the potteries like now? How have they changed? How did Josiah Wedgwood inspire others?

Our big question for the term is **"What do Christians believe God was like?"**. Over the term we will be exploring how:

Christians believe in God, and that they find out about God in the Bible. Christians believe God is loving, kind, fair and forgiving, and also Lord and King.

Some stories show these Christian beliefs.

Christians worship God and try to live in ways that please him.

Children will continue to learn to play the drums and will be performing what they have learnt to the school and parents.

This term in PE, we will be practising our athletics skills in preparation for sports day. These will include running, throwing and jumping. We will also be learning how to use a bat accurately in tennis and badminton.

Literacy



During this term, we will continue to refine the basic skills of writing and look more closely at grammatical terms.

Through the story of Jack and the Baked Beanstalk, we will be revising both simple and compound sentences. We will continue to practice writing these and develop our understanding of sentence variety.

Our new learning will include writing sentences containing the conjunctions; **when**, **if** and **because**.

We will also be learning about proper nouns and commas for lists.

Maths

This term, **Y1** will be covering the topics of:

- Measurement of length height mass and capacity.
- Multiplication and division including fractions
- Position and direction
- Time and money



Y2 will be covering the topics of:

- Measurement of mass, capacity and temperature
- Fractions
- Time
- Statistics
- Position and direction

Science

This term we will be finding out about the basic needs of animals, including humans, for survival (water, food and air) - describe the importance for humans of exercise, eating the right amounts of different types of food, and hygiene. We will be learning to identify, name, draw and label the basic parts of the human body and say which part of the body is associated with each sense.



/DT

In art this term, we will be looking at Sculpture as an art form. Alongside making our own sculpture of a bird, we will be exploring shape, line, colour, texture and pattern in our sketch books. We will also be learning how to manipulate different materials to make our sculptures stand.

In DT we will be continuing with the theme of sculptures but using natural materials.

PSHE

This term our PSHE will be taught by our new school mental health support worker. She will be teaching the children about reading emotions and building resilience.
